Joining the Parents 2 Partners (P2P) Teacher Fellow cohort will help you develop your capacity and learn innovative ways to engage diverse families, allowing you to make an greater impact in your classroom, school, and community.

Who Should Apply for the Fellowship?

We are looking for K-12 educators serving in high need schools and communities who aspire to better connect with their students and their families. Educators must work full-time in Ohio schools.

In the P2P Cohort, you will:

- Experience **“SELF” care** first-hand and learn how to develop resilience in the face of challenges such as those encountered when working in high need communities.
- Expand your knowledge of **cultural topics**, essential when working with diverse youth and their caregivers.
- Increase your knowledge of resources and opportunities available to **elevate your teaching**.
- Boost your **skills** through hands-on workshops, training, and mentoring projects.
- Broaden your horizons by learning with and from peers around the state and increase your **network** among educators and community leaders.
- Become part of an experiential **learning lab** that equips you with the skills and confidence to initiate a project of your choice and promote parental engagement.
- Design **collaborative solutions** to increase parental engagement and support all learners.
- **Develop a project** and receive feedback from other fellows to improve plans and make it even more impactful.
- Apply for a **mini-grant** to get you started, supported, and celebrated.
- Increase your **voice for advocacy** and visibility
- Track your time to earn Continuing Education Hours and a Certificate of Completion

Characteristics we are looking for in candidates include educators who are eager to join the cohort, have a curiosity for learning more about different cultural norms and expectations, respect diversity, demonstrate interest in improving their cultural understanding, and have personal motivation, initiative, and ability to work in teams.

Joining the P2P Teacher Fellow Cohort is a time commitment, and fellows are expected to be engaged throughout the program. If selected for the fellowship, our commitment to you is to constantly support and challenge you on your path by developing your capacity and empowering you with resources, through learning, exposure, mentoring, and more. This is only effective if you are equally committed.

Fellow must attend a weekly event, engage in online learning activities, be open-minded, and are encouraged to apply for a mini-grant to initiate a project. Those are core activities through which you will **build your leadership capacity, grow your spheres of influence** and—later, **make an impact as a problem solver** in your expanding network.
